

First Aid Training under the Red Traffic Light – Covid Protection Framework

Following the transition to the Covid Protection Framework on 3 December 2021, MediTrain will be able to provide training at venues in Auckland. MediTrain is a Tertiary Education Provider (and our students are in close proximity) so we are subject to greater restrictions than other businesses.

We are taking extra hygiene measures (such as thorough cleaning of manikins and hand-washing) to ensure everyone's safety. We will be offering First Aid courses with the following requirements at the Red Traffic Light:

- All students will need to show a vaccine pass, and our instructors are fully vaccinated.
- Students will need to maintain 1-metre of physical distancing from each other and from the instructor, including while demonstrating CPR.
- Students will need to wear a mask and we will have disposable masks available if needed. If a student has a medical condition which prevents them from wearing a mask, our instructor will need to view an exemption card.
- Class sizes are limited to 16 students.
- Students are required to sign in using the Covid Tracer app or using the sign-in form.
- Hand sanitiser and gloves will be provided.
- Practical demonstration of compressions as part of CPR will be required, but rescue breaths will not be demonstrated.
- Those practical activities which would involve contact between students will not take place.

These requirements are accurate as at 30 November 2021. We note that government regulations and industry-specific guidelines from New Zealand Qualifications Authority may change at any time.

- Those practical activities which would involve contact between students will not take place.
